Overhead Crane Operator Training Site Requirements

All of Fulford Certification's training programs are delivered on your worksite. The following site requirements are needed for us to deliver our courses.

Meeting Room

A meeting room with sufficient space for the course participants and the instructor is required for the delivery of the theory section of the course. A lunch room or similar space can be used but must be closed to staff not taking the training.

Work Area with Overhead Crane

The hands-on section of the training requires access to a work area (yard, warehouse, etc) and use of an overhead crane to rig and move loads for the entire afternoon. The crane must be in good working order, have a valid safety inspection, logbook and operators manual. Access to the crane's disconnect is also required.

Objects for Lifting & Rigging

Objects over 500 lbs and less than 50% of the hoisting device's capacity must be available to be rigged and moved by the training participants. The instructor will bring some rigging to the site but access to additional slings and hardware that the trainees will be using on the job is valuable.
