- All non-critical lifts performed by the apprentice / trainee operator must be under indirect supervision of a qualified supervisor†.
- All critical lifts (as defined by WorkSafeBC) performed by the apprentice / trainee operator may only be under direct supervision‡ of a qualified supervisor†.

- † The employer is to ensure that the **supervisor** is properly trained and that there is a **plan for supervision**.
